



SHOWER DOOR GLASS & HARDWARE CLEANING GUIDE



Glass Cleaning Tips

Recommended Frequency:

Clean your glass weekly to prevent buildup of soap scum, hard water stains, and mildew.

Daily Maintenance (Optional but Effective):

- Use a squeegee after each shower to remove water droplets.
- Keep the shower well-ventilated to reduce humidity and mildew.

Weekly Deep Clean:

- Use a non-abrasive glass cleaner such as: Sprayway Glass Cleaner
- Rejuvenate Soap Scum Remover
- Method Glass + Surface Cleaner
- Apply cleaner with a soft microfiber cloth or sponge.
- Avoid ammonia-based cleaners, as they can damage protective coatings.



Extra Tips

Keep a squeegee hanging inside the shower for convenience.

Consider applying a glass sealant every 6–12 months if your glass is not pre-coated.

Always test a new product on a small, inconspicuous area first.



Hardware Care Tips

Routine Cleaning:

- Wipe hardware with a damp microfiber cloth weekly.
- Dry immediately with a clean cloth to prevent water spotting.

Avoid:

- Abrasive pads or scouring powders
- Strong chemicals (bleach, ammonia, or alcohol)
- Soaking hardware (especially around seals or hinges)

For Tough Build-up:

- Mix a small amount of dish soap with warm water.
- Use a soft toothbrush to gently scrub detailed areas.

Note: Matte and specialty finishes may show fingerprints or water spots more easily — regular wiping helps maintain appearance.
