Our tabletops are made to fit your specific needs, with the ability to add holes, curved corners, and custom shapes for desks, dining tables, and more. Please note: beveling is not available on curved cuts.

Choosing the right edge finish is essential for both safety and aesthetics. We offer a variety of edge treatments to suit your project:

- **Seamed Edge**

The most economical choice. Sharp edges are lightly sanded (also known as a chamfered or swiped edge) to make the glass safe to handle. Best for glass with hidden or framed edges, not recommended for exposed applications.

- **Flat Polished Edge**

Our most popular decorative edge. The glass is ground smooth and polished to a crystal-clear finish, with a subtle 45° angle on the top and bottom. Ideal for frameless or exposed-edge installations.

- **Flat Ground Edge**

Similar in shape to flat polish but with a matte, frosted look. The edge is sanded rather than buffed, creating a softer, opaque finish.

- **Pencil Polished Edge**


This rounded edge mimics the curve of a pencil, polished to a clear finish. Perfect for round tables or furniture with curved corners.

- **Pencil Ground Edge**

Like pencil polish, but with a matte finish. A great choice when you want a rounded shape without the shine.

- **Beveled Edge**


Beveled glass features an angled cut along the perimeter (less than 90°), creating a prismatic effect that reflects light beautifully. A popular decorative upgrade for rectangular and square tabletops. Not available on curved shapes.




Flat Grind



Flat Polished




Pencil Grind
